## **Tree Walk in Knolls Wood, Leighton Buzzard**

Bob Morwood (BGT Committee member and arboriculturist) will lead an informal 1½ hour walk in Knolls Wood, an area of ornamental woodland planted on former heathland from the 1840s. By 1871, 250 different species were recorded. The Wood contains an avenue of “monkey puzzles” (*araucaria araucana*) and redwoods as well as many deciduous trees. Afterwards join us at the nearby Heath Inn, Heath & Reach.

### **DIRECTIONS**

Knolls Woods is situated on the east side of Plantation Road, Leighton Buzzard.  
**Nearest Postcode - LU7 3JB.**

**From Leighton Buzzard town centre** head for Woburn on North Street, Church Street then go left at the fork onto Plantation Road. Follow the road for about half a mile until Taylors Ride is on the left. Should be OK to park there.

**From Woburn** head for Leighton Buzzard (NOT THE HOCKLIFFE ROAD) going towards the A5 and Heath & Reach. At the junction with the A5 roundabout go straight across. Follow the road for a couple of miles and enter Heath and Reach. Go past the Heath Inn on the left, and at the sharp left bend turn right onto Linslade Road. Follow this for ¾ mile to the crossroads. Turn left onto Plantation Rd, drive past the golf club and in ¼ mile reach Taylors Ride on the right.
