Visit the Spring Flowers






at Clapham Park Wood

The woods were extended in the late 1990s. It has a rich history with earthworks possibly dating from the Iron Age. It has been used as a deer park and part of the wood contains ridge



and furrow earthworks. It has a good show of spring woodland flowers.
