This new autumn programme will cover garden history from the first known gardens of Persia; through medieval, Tudor, Jacobean gardens then onto Brown, Repton and the Landscape movement. Victorian gardens, both design and new technologies, Arts & Crafts gardens and the new emphasis on landscape design in the mid-20th century postwar era will complete the introductory course.

Kate Harwood is a former university lecturer on garden history, a member of Hertfordshire Gardens Trust and has given many talks and lectures on garden history.
