Gertrude Jekyll in Bedfordshire

2018 was the 175th anniversary of the birth of Gertrude Jekyll (1843-1932) who created some 400 gardens. Her influence on garden design has been pervasive.

Although one of her brothers lived in Bedfordshire, Gertrude only produced plans for one garden in the county at the Old House in Ickwell. Arts & Crafts architects also redesigned the house. When the owners moved, they created a new house with a Jekyll inspired garden at Ickwell Bury.
