

# Luton Hoo Estate Walled Garden in the 20<sup>th</sup> Century

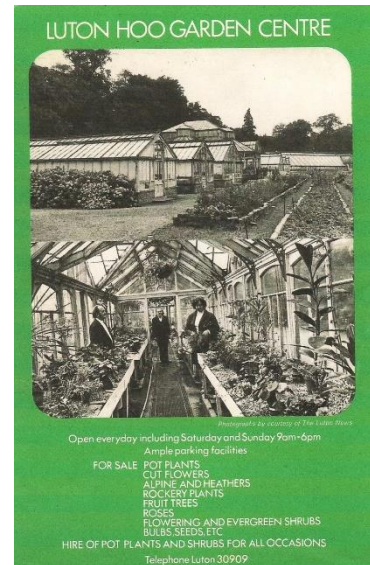
Illustrated Talk

New evidence from Oral Histories and other research has provided a much better understanding of what happened in both the Walled Garden and the Estate before and after two World Wars. Many estates

declined irreversibly after both wars but Luton Hoo soldiered on. Details gathered about WW1 soldiers, the Estate Fire Brigade, opening of the Wernher Collection in the Mansion, or the Garden Centre paint a vivid picture. The plan of the walled garden drawn by a gardener who worked on the estate in the 1950's and 60's provides minute details including the trees in the orchard!

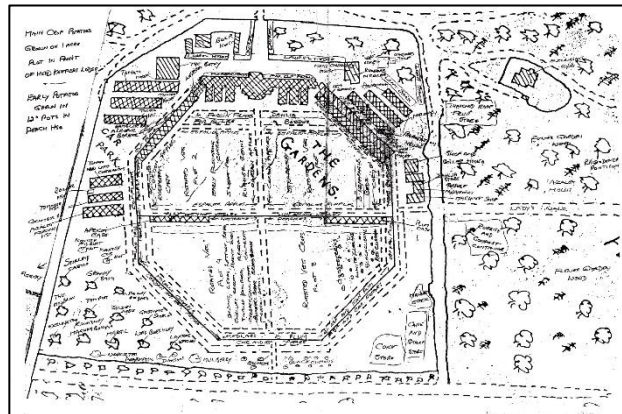
